## Mike:

This is quite disconcerting at the very minimum, and I am wondering what the USPS's plans are are to provide a <u>safe and secure</u> place for our employees and their vehicles. While I realize this is an issue for the Orlando Police Department and the employees auto insurance companies, providing a **safe and secure** environment for our employees is of paramount importance, and should be the chief priority in the Orlando P&DC. This very well could have ended up worse than vandalism, and our employee's safety is of principal importance.

Are the parking lot cameras operational? If not, why, and if so are they being looked at by the authorities? What is the possibility of having some sort of gate installed to where the employee's badges can gain them access? With all of the monies the USPS appears to have been spending, and the ongoing emphasis on Safety from the USPS, this idea would seem to be a priority. Could you look into this at the District and Area levels to see if that is feasible?
