Mike:

This letter is a follow-up to my first inquiry sent to you on July 26, 2018. I am still awaiting a response as one of our employee's vehicles was vandalized in the Plant parking lot. Apparently, someone poured some type of chemical liquid on the vehicle and ruined the paint. I am wondering what the USPS's plans are to provide a **safe and secure** place for our employees and their vehicles. Providing a **safe and secure** environment for our employees is of principal importance, and should be the foremost priority in the Orlando P&DC. This very well could have ended up worse than vandalism, and our employee's safety is of chief importance.

1. Are the parking lot cameras operational? If not, why, and if so are they being looked at by the authorities?
2. What is the possibility of having some sort of gate installed to where the employee's badges can gain them access? With all of the monies the USPS appears to have been spending, and the ongoing emphasis on Safety from the USPS, this idea would seem to be a priority. Could you look into this at the District and Area levels to see if that is feasible?
3. Have you contacted the Postal Inspectors, Area and District Safety as of yet? If not, why not, and if so, what were the results?
