Local news and updates:

• Our LMOU (Local Memorandum of Understanding) negotiations will be starting within the next two weeks and will last approximately 30 days. As President and chief spokesman, my intent is to open them up and attempt to strengthen all of our LMOUs, not just in the three Plants we



- represent, but in all of the approximately 105 Stations/Branches/Installations within our local. As a team we will strengthen the language, remove unnecessary items, and produce concise and understandable documents.
- The Chatter, which is our local newsletter, will be arriving in your homes within a couple of weeks. We will be soliciting any ideas that you may have to see if these are contractual and can be incorporated into our Local Memorandums of Understanding (LMOU) meetings since we are always interested in our member's ideas.
- I will be conducting our fourth Steward's Training Class this year within the next 3-4 weeks. If you are interested in becoming a Steward/Alternate on your Tour and/or Station/Installation, let me know. It is always advantageous to have an APWU presence in every office if possible. You will be provided the tools and guidance necessary to handle issues that arise.
- We have just had approximately 40 PSEs converted to career within our local on September 3, 2016. These conversions were from all three crafts: Clerk, Maintenance, and Motor Vehicle. I wanted to say congratulations to all of the newly converted members! We are still actively fighting for conversions to career for all of the PSEs (Postal Support Employees) within OUR local and will not give up that fight!
- We are still seeing a lot of discipline such as: Letters of Warning, Suspensions, and even Removals. Attendance is the most prevalent issue in these instances of discipline.
- We were the Host Local for the 2016 National Convention at the Dolphin Hotel in Orlando Florida two weeks ago. Our local did a great job and I wanted to thank everyone that assisted.
- **ALWAYS** request your Steward when you are having an Investigative Interview, and **NEVER** go in alone with the Postal Inspectors or the OIG! We have had some instances of bullying in a couple of our installations from the management ranks. If that does happen it needs to be reported!

In closing, remember to always speak to a non-member and explain to them why they should become a member of the organization that fights for <u>every</u> aspect of their livelihood. Organizing our workplace is one of the most important goals of the APWU. We will be having an organizing campaign locally in the upcoming future and I will let you all know the plan and how to get involved as that time approaches.
